


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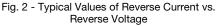


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Fig. 1 - Maximum Forward Voltage Drop Characteristics








Fig. 3 - Typical Junction Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage





Fig. 4 - Maximum Thermal Impedance Z<sub>thJC</sub> Characteristics

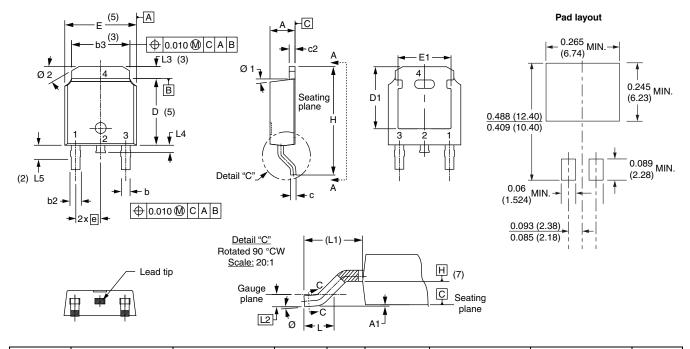
