

Installing Driver for USB programmer Quickstart Guide


Step 1

After connecting the USB programmer (or the development board with the integrated programmer) to the USB port of PC, the operation system will ask you for necessary drivers. Choose *"Install from a list or specific location (Advanced)"* and click *"Next"*.



Step 2

Now you need to enter the path to the drivers on CD. Folder *"Drivers"* contains driver for XP-2000 operating systems. Choose it and click *"Next"*.



Step 3

If the location you specified is correct, Windows will locate the drivers and proceed with the installation.



Step 4


After Windows has installed the necessary drivers, you will be notified by the following window. Click "Finish" to complete the installation process.



Installation Check

You can check if the installation was successful from "Device Manager" (the programmer or development board needs to be connected to the PC).

Near the bottom of the list you should find the entry "USB Devices by mikroElektronika" containing "USB18F USB Communication Device".



Uninstalling Driver for USB programmer Quickstart Guide



If you need to uninstall the driver for USB programmer from the PC, follow the procedure described below.

Step 1

Connect the USB programmer or development board to the PC. Open the "Device Manager" and expand the entry "USB Devices by mikroElektronika" by clicking the + sign.

Now right-click the "USB18F USB Communication Device" and select "Uninstall".



Step 2

You will be prompted to confirm the uninstall. Answer by clicking "OK". Windows will uninstall the driver after which you need to disconnect the programmer or development board from the PC.

Reconnecting the programmer or development board will start over the installation process described previously in the document.
