
#### **Product Description**

GRF4002W is a broadband low noise gain block designed for small cell, wireless infrastructure and other high performance applications. It exhibits outstanding broadband NF, linearity and return losses over 700 to 3800 MHz with a single match.

The device is operated from a supply voltage ( $V_{DD}$ ) of 1.8 to 5.0 V with a selectable IDDQ range of 20 to 80 mA for optimal efficiency and linearity.

GRF4002W is internally matched to  $50\Omega$  at the input and output ports, needing only external DC blocks and a bias choke on the output.





#### GRF4002W Evaluation Board Performance over Temperature: (5V/70mA)









#### GRF4002W Evaluation Board Performance over Temperature: (5V/70mA)





### GRF4002W Evaluation Board S-Pars: (0.7 – 3.8 GHz Match)








#### GRF4002W Evaluation Board Stability Mu/Mu Prime Factors: (0.7 – 3.8 GHz Match)





#### **GRF4002W Evaluation Board Assembly Diagram**






#### **GRF4002-W Bias Resistor Selection Chart**







#### 1.5 mm DFN-6 Package Dimensions



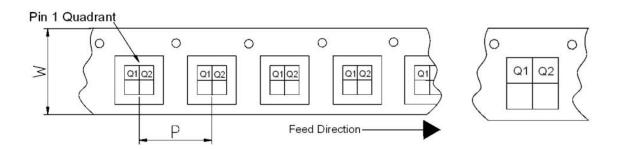
#### Tape and Reel Information:
