1. General description

74AHC1G14-Q100 and 74AHCT1G14-Q100 are high-speed Si-gate CMOS devices. They provide an inverting buffer function with Schmitt trigger action. These devices are capable of transforming slowly changing input signals into sharply defined, jitter-free output signals.

The AHC device has CMOS input switching levels and supply voltage range 2 V to 5.5 V.

The AHCT device has TTL input switching levels and supply voltage range 4.5 V to 5.5 V.

This product has been qualified to the Automotive Electronics Council (AEC) standard Q100 (Grade 1) and is suitable for use in automotive applications.











The slow input rise and fall times cause additional power dissipation, which can be calculated using the following formula:

 $P_{add} = f_i x (t_r x \Delta I_{CC(AV)} + t_f x \Delta I_{CC(AV)}) x V_{CC}$ where:

- P_{add} = additional power dissipation (μW);
- f_i = input frequency (MHz);
- t_r = input rise time (ns); 10 % to 90 %;
- t_f = input fall time (ns); 90 % to 10 %;
- $\Delta I_{CC(AV)}$ = average additional supply current (µA).

Average additional I_{CC} differs with positive or negative input transitions, as shown in Fig. 14 and Fig. 15.






Fig. 18. Package outline SOT353-1 (TSSOP5)




Fig. 19. Package outline SOT753 (SC-74A)
