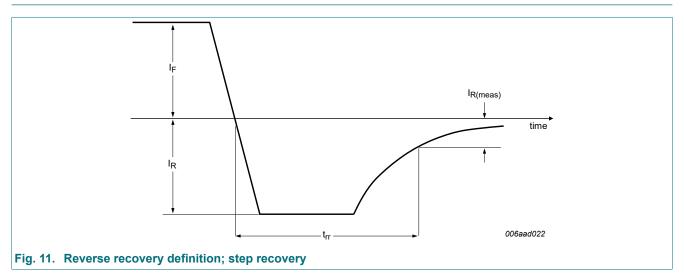
#### 650 V, 3 A ultrafast recovery rectifier



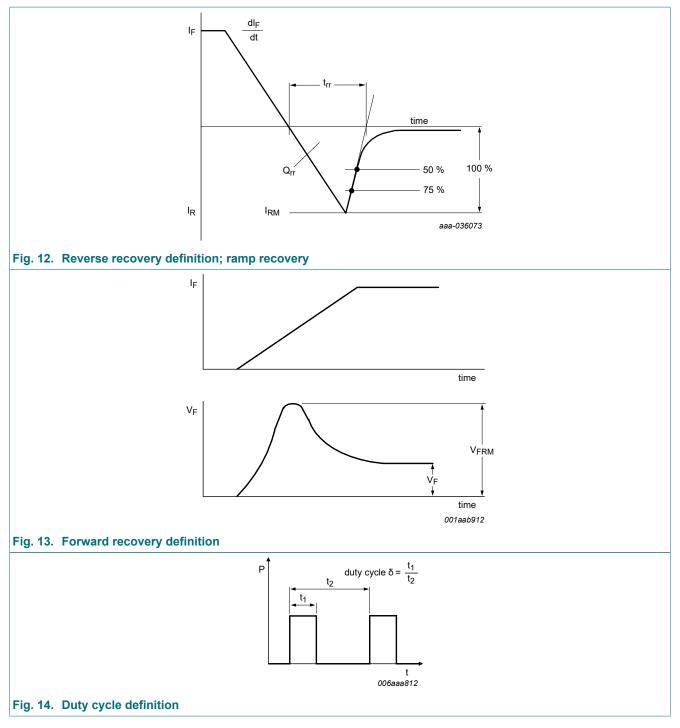

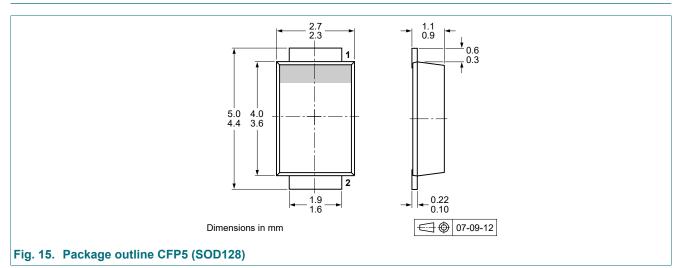

 $I_{F(AV)}$  =  $I_M$  ×  $\delta$  with  $I_M$  defined as peak current

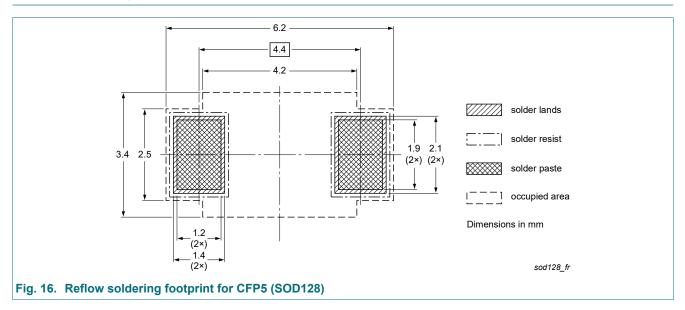

with  $\mathsf{I}_{\mathsf{RMS}}$  defined as RMS current.

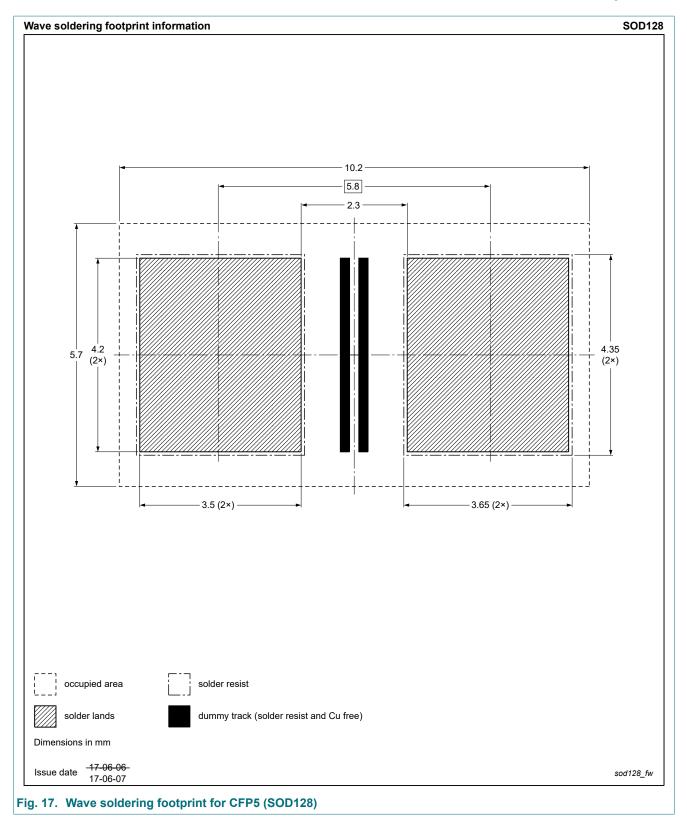
